**JOB GOAL:** This individual provides technical services and support to district technology system and computer users beyond that of what a first-level computer support technician can; deliver, setup, and demonstrate use of end-user computing/processing devices as well as other systems or applications in use at the district; troubleshoot end-user computing or processing devices with ability to determine whether issue is within the end-user device or the network/server; escalate issues as necessary to upper-level staff; and perform a variety of tasks relative to assigned area of responsibility; on occasion, this position receives functional and technical input from upper-level technical staff.

### **PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Responds in a timely manner to help-desk requests and meets deadlines on assigned projects.
2. Assists in maintaining accurate records for inventory and repair/maintenance work.
3. Establishes and carries out preventative maintenance schedule for all hardware/software systems.

5. Works with vendors in the repair and maintenance of equipment.
6. Works as a team member with other technical staff to communicate problems and solutions to ensure timely response and problem resolution for end users.
