





Please follow these directions from within your Chrome browser:

1. Click on the three dots in the top right corner of your screen. They should be to the right of your initial or profile picture in the task bar.





2. Click on or hover over help at the bottom of the menu. A fly out menu will appear that lists "About Google Chrome" as an option.





3. Click on "About Google Chrome." If you do not see the latest version of Chrome, Version 89.0.4389.90, follow the instructions on screen to update Chrome.



4. Once updated, it will require you to relaunch your browser. *Please make sure that you have saved your work and you are not in the middle of something when you relaunch.*
